



Inflation trends in the regions

May 2024

Annual inflation in May 2024 amounted to 8.5% (in April – 8.7%). The prices for food slowed down in annual terms to 5.5% (in April - 6.3%), for non-food products remained unchanged at 7.6% (in April - 7.6%), and for paid services accelerated to 13.9% (in April – 13.5%).

By regions annual inflation slowed down in 16 regions, accelerated in 1 region and remained unchanged in 3 regions. Annual inflation was higher than the national level in 10 regions. The highest inflation rates were recorded in Karagandy region (10.5%) and Astana city (10.4%).

Food prices rose in Kazakhstan higher than the national level (5.5% YoY) in Almaty city (8.3%), Ulytau (8.1%), Zhetysu (7.2%), North Kazakhstan (7.0%), Akmola and Mangystau (6.9% each), East Kazakhstan (6.6%), West Kazakhstan (6.0%) and Atyrau (5.9%) regions.

The increase in prices for non-food products is higher than in the country (7.6% YoY) was noted in Mangystau (14.2%), Karagandy (10.0%) regions, Shymkent city (8.8%), Western Kazakhstan (8.7%), Akmola (8.4%), Turkistan (8.3%) regions and Astana city (8.2%).

Above the national level (13.9% YoY) prices for paid services rose in the following regions: Karagandy (18.0%), Pavlodar (17.7%), Aktobe (17.5%), Atyrau (16.5%), North Kazakhstan regions and Astana city (16.2% each), Zhetysu (15.9%), East Kazakhstan (15.6%) and Abai (15.2%) regions.

In May 2024 **monthly inflation** in the country was **0.4%**, which is lower than historical averageⁱ (0.5% in May 2017-2021). The highest monthly inflation was noted in Astana city (1.2%).
