The National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan is now accepting applications for participation in the **scientific and practical conference** dedicated to research in monetary policy and financial stability.

The conference will be held in Almaty in April-May 2025.

Researchers, experts, and practitioners working in the fields of economics, finance, and related disciplines are invited to participate as speakers.

Applications for participation with a presentation are accepted in the following thematic areas:

- Long-term trends and new challenges in monetary policy;
- Inflation and inflation expectations;
- The impact of macroeconomic changes on financial stability;
- The role of central banks in maintaining financial stability;
- Risks and challenges for financial markets and institutions.

The presentation must include the results of a scientific study conducted using modern research methodology. The duration of the presentation should not exceed 20 minutes.

The application for a presentation must include:

- Applicant's information (full name, academic degree, place of work, brief biography);
- Indication of the thematic area to which the presentation relates;
- A detailed abstract of the presentation in PDF format, ranging from 2,000 to 7,000 characters. The abstract should provide a clear description of the problem under consideration, research methodology, main findings, their justification, and novelty.
