

In June 2026 the volume of remittances transferred via international money transfer systems (hereinafter - IMTS) was 165.2 thousand transactions in the amount of 67.6 billion tenge. Compared to May 2026, there is a increase in the number of transfers by 9.5% and a decrease in the volume of transactions by 21.9%.

Kazakhstan's commercial banks and JSC «Kazpost» provide to the customer's remittances services through IMTS such as the Golden Crown, Western Union, MoneyGram and others IMTS.

IMTS are used by the Kazakhstan's population as for transfers within the country and for sending /receiving money transfers abroad / from abroad.

The share of remittances carried out through IMTS on the territory of Kazakhstan in June 2026 is 3.0% of the total number of transfers and 3.5% of the total volume of remittances. The share of remittances sent abroad is 97.0% and 96.5%, respectively.

CROSS-BORDER REMITTANCES

REMMITANCES SENT ABROAD

In June 2026 abroad were transferred via IMTS 160.3 thousand transactions in the amount of 65.2 billion tenge. Compared to May 2026, the number of money transfers sent increased by 9.3%, the volume of transactions increased by 21.8%.

In terms of the volume of money sent from Kazakhstan abroad, the leaders are: Uzbekistan – 23.0 billion tenge (share of the total amount – 35.2%), Russia – 21.2 billion tenge (share – 32.6%), Turkey – 8.6 billion tenge (share – 13.2%), Georgia – 3.7 billion tenge (share – 5.6%), as well as Kyrgyzstan – 2.0 billion tenge (share – 3.1%).

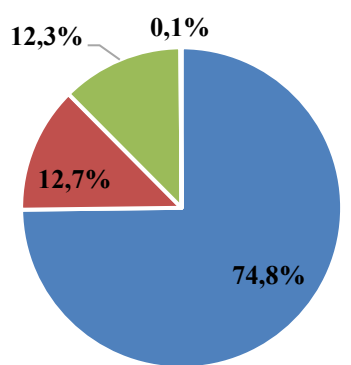

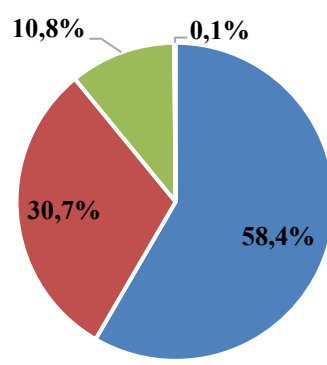
The main share of carried out remittances sent via IMTS was in Kazakhstan tenge (the share of the total number of sent transfers was 74.8%, the share of the total volume of sent transfers was 58.4%) and in US dollars (12.7% and 30.7%, respectively).

RECEIVED REMITTANCES (FROM ABROAD)

In June 2026 from abroad to Kazakhstan were transferred via IMTS 44.9 thousand transactions in the amount of 18.3 billion tenge. Compared to April 2026, the number of money transfers received increased by 12.7%, the volume of transactions increased by 21.8%.

In terms of the amount of money received from abroad, the leaders are: Russia – 4.2 billion tenge (share of the total amount – 23.1%), the United States of America – 3.1 billion tenge (share – 16.9%), Turkey – 2.7 billion tenge (share – 15.0%), Uzbekistan – 1.7 billion tenge (share – 9.4%), as well as Germany – 1.4 billion tenge (share – 7.5%).

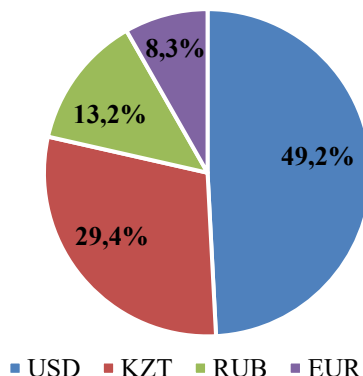
