

In July 2026 the volume of remittances transferred via international money transfer systems (hereinafter - IMTS) was 130.3 thousand transactions in the amount of 59.1 billion tenge. Compared to June 2026, there is a decrease in the number of transfers by 21.1% and a decrease in the volume of transactions by 12.5%.

Kazakhstan's commercial banks and JSC «Kazpost» provide to the customer's remittances services through IMTS such as the Western Union, MoneyGram and others IMTS.

IMTS are used by the Kazakhstan's population as for transfers within the country and for sending /receiving money transfers abroad / from abroad.

The share of remittances carried out through IMTS on the territory of Kazakhstan in July 2026 is 3.1% of the total number of transfers and 4.6% of the total volume of remittances. The share of remittances sent abroad is 96.9% and 95.4%, respectively.

CROSS-BORDER REMITTANCES

REMMITTANCES SENT ABROAD

In July 2026 abroad were transferred via IMTS 126.2 thousand transactions in the amount of 56.3 billion tenge. Compared to June 2026, the number of money transfers sent decreased by 21.3%, the volume of transactions decreased by 13.5%.

In terms of the volume of money sent from Kazakhstan abroad, the leaders are: Uzbekistan – 20.3 billion tenge (share of the total amount – 36.1%), Russia – 17.1 billion tenge (share – 30.4%), Turkey – 5.9 billion tenge (share – 10.4%), Georgia – 3.9 billion tenge (share – 6.9%), as well as Kyrgyzstan – 2.9 billion tenge (share – 5.2%).

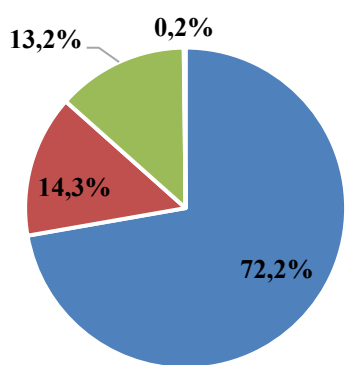

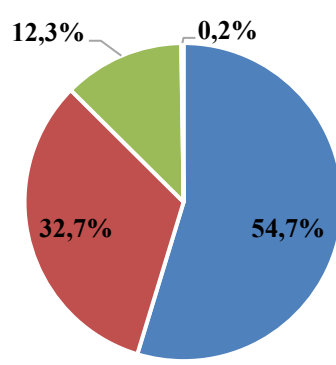
The main share of carried out remittances sent via IMTS was in Kazakhstan tenge (the share of the total number of sent transfers was 72.2%, the share of the total volume of sent transfers was 54.7%) and in US dollars (14.3% and 32.7%, respectively).

RECEIVED REMITTANCES (FROM ABROAD)

In July 2026 from abroad to Kazakhstan were transferred via IMTS 38.6 thousand transactions in the amount of 15.9 billion tenge. Compared to June 2026, the number of money transfers received decreased by 14.0%, the volume of transactions decreased by 13.1%.

In terms of the amount of money received from abroad, the leaders are: United States of America – 2.9 billion tenge (share of the total amount – 18.5%), Russia – 2.9 billion tenge (share – 17.9%), Turkey – 2.0 billion tenge (share – 12.5%), Uzbekistan – 1.8 billion tenge (share – 11.2%), as well as Germany – 1.2 billion tenge (share – 7.4%).

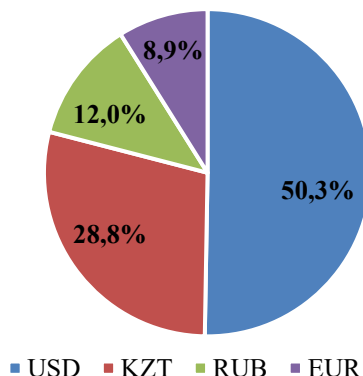

Main share of received remittances carried out through IMTS were transferred in US dollars (50.3% of total number of remittances and 63.1% of the total volume) and Kazakhstan tenge (28.8% and 23.7%, respectively).
