Inflation trends in the regions

July 2022

Annual inflation in July 2022 amounted to 15.0% (in June - 14.5%). Prices of food products over the year increased by 19.7% (in June - 19.2%), for non-food products - by 14.2% (in June - 13.2%), and for paid services - kept the previous value at the level of 9.2%.

By regions annual inflation accelerated in 16 regions, slowed down in 3 regions and remained unchanged in 1 region. The greatest acceleration was recorded in Atyrau region (from 14.1% in June to 16.0% in July). A slowdown in annual inflation was noted in Almaty (from 14.3% to 13.4%), Karaganda (from 15.5% to 15.3%) and Zhetysu (from 15.0% to 14.9%) regions. Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 10 regions, among which the highest value was recorded in Mangystau region (17.9%).

Food products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (19.7% YoY) in Mangystau (24.0%), Aktobe (22.4%), Atyrau (21.5%), Akmola (20.8%) regions, Almaty city (20.5%), Turkistan (20.3%), Zhambyl (20.2%), Kostanay (20.0%) and North-Kazakhstan (19.9%) regions.

Prices of **non-food** products are higher than in the country (14.2% YoY) increased in Nur-Sultan city and Ulytau region (18.5% each), as well as Mangystau (16.2%), East Kazakhstan (16.0%), Atyrau (15.8%), Karaganda (15.6%), Abai (15.4%), Akmola (15.3%), Zhetysu (14.6%) and Kyzylorda (14.4%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country remained unchanged at the level of 9.2% YoY, while the growth was higher than the national level in Turkistan (11.4%), East Kazakhstan (11.2%), Mangystau (11.0%), Abai (10.7%), Karaganda (10.5%), West Kazakhstan (10.2%), Akmola (9.7%) regions, Almaty (9.5%) and Shymkent (9.4%) cities, as well as Ulytau region (9.4%).

In July 2022 **monthly** inflation in the country amounted to **1.1%**, which is significantly higher than the average July inflation over the past 5 years (for 2017-2021). In all regions, prices rose above the historical average in July 2022. The greatest acceleration of monthly inflation was noted in Atyrau region (2.1%).
