*On issue of the commemorative coins “Pavlodar”,  
“Atyrau” and “Aktau” from “Cities of Kazakhstan”  
series of coins*

The National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan announces the issue, effective from 2 November 2012, of the commemorative coins “Pavlodar”, “Atyrau” and “Aktau” from the “Cities of Kazakhstan” series of coins, made of nickel-silver alloy, of the nominal value 50 tenge.

“**Pavlodar**”, “**Atyrau**” and “**Aktau**” commemorative coins have identical images on the face. In the central part of the face (obverse) there is a legend “50 TENGE”, which denotes the nominal value of the coins. In the upper part there is an ornamental octangular rosette, and in the lower part there is an element of the national ornament. To the right of the nominal value there is an abbreviation “ҚҰБ”. Protruding edge runs around the full-circle.

On the back side (reverse) of the commemorative coin “**Pavlodar**”, in its central part, there is the emblem of the city of Pavlodar. Around the full-circle there is a legend “ҚАЗАҚСТАН РЕСПУБЛИКАСЫ” (KAZAKSTAN RESPUBLIKASY”) in the state language, the number “2012”, which denotes the year of mintage and protruding edge. The legend and number are separated by dots.

On the back side (reverse) of the commemorative coin “**Atyrau**”, in its central part, there is the emblem of the city of Atyrau. Around the full-circle there is a legend “ҚАЗАҚСТАН РЕСПУБЛИКАСЫ” (KAZAKSTAN RESPUBLIKASY”) in the state language, the number “2012”, which denotes the year of mintage and protruding edge. The legend and number are separated by dots.

On the back side (reverse) of the commemorative coin “**Aktau**”, in its central part, there is the emblem of the city of Aktau. Around the full-circle there is a legend “ҚАЗАҚСТАН РЕСПУБЛИКАСЫ” (KAZAKSTAN RESPUBLIKASY”) in the state language, the number “2012”, which denotes the year of mintage and protruding edge. The legend and number are separated by dots.

Images and legends on the obverse and reverse of the coins are relief.

The lateral surface (gurt) is grooved.





The coins are made of the nickel-silver alloy; diameter is 23 mm; weight is 4.71 g; mintage is 50 thousand pieces of each coin.

Commemorative coins of the nominal values of KZT 50 are mandatory for acceptance at their face value throughout the Republic of Kazakhstan for all types of payments as well as for credit to the accounts, placement on deposits, for letters of credit and for money transfers; they are changed and exchanged without limitation in all banks of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

### **Comments of the National Bank of Kazakhstan**

Commemorative coins are made at the Republican State Enterprise on the Right of Economic Management “Kazakhstan Mint of the National Bank of the Republic of Kazakhstan”.

The coins are designed in accordance with the Concept of Design of Banknotes and Coins of the National Currency – Kazakhstani Tenge approved by the Decree No. 1193 of 25 September 2003 of the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan.

One thousand of commemorative coins of each type are brilliant uncirculated and are packed in special plastic thermal vacuum wraps for sale.
