



# Inflation trends in the regions

March 2024

Annual inflation in March 2024 amounted to 9.1% (in February – 9.3%). The prices for food and non-food products slowed down in annual terms to 6.9% (in February – 7.4%) and to 8.2% (in February – 8.5%), respectively, and for paid services accelerated to 13.2% (in February – 12.8%).

By regions annual inflation slowed down in 14 regions, accelerated in 5 regions and remained unchanged in 1 region. Annual inflation was higher than the national level in 10 regions. The highest inflation rates were recorded in Karagandy (10.8%) and Mangystau (10.1%) regions.

Food prices rose in Kazakhstan higher than the national level (6.9% YoY) in Ulytau region (10.5%), Almaty city (9.0%), Akmola (8.5%), Zhetysu (8. 4%), East Kazakhstan (8.1%), North Kazakhstan (7.8%), Mangystau (7.6%), West Kazakhstan (7.5%), Zhambyl (7.4%) and Abai (7.3%) regions.

The increase in prices for non-food products is higher than in the country (8.2% YoY) was noted in Mangystau region (13.2%), Shymkent city (9.7%), West Kazakhstan and Karagandy regions (9.4% each), Akmola (8.6%), Zhambyl and Kyzylorda (8.4% each) regions.

Above the national level (13.2% YoY) prices for paid services rose in the following regions: Pavlodar (18.2%), Karagandy (17.4%), Atyrau (16.6%), North Kazakhstan (16.3%), Aktobe (16.1%), Abai (15.1%), East Kazakhstan (14.3%), Zhetysu (14.2%), Turkistan (14.0%) regions and Shymkent city (13.7%).

In March 2024 **monthly inflation** in the country was **0.7%**, which is higher than the historical average<sup>i</sup> (0.6% in March 2017-2021). The highest monthly inflation was noted in Pavlodar region (2.1%).
