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


Number of respondents in March 2021 - 459 enterprises




- The business activity index is a composite indicator that includes the aggregate of enterprises' answers to questions regarding the actual changes in the economic indicators of enterprises and the expectations regarding their changes in the future.
- The National Bank of Kazakhstan conducts a survey of enterprises participating in the monitoring of the real sector on a monthly basis



### ENTERPRISES-RESPONDENTS BY INDUSTRY





#### CONSOLIDATED BUSINESS ACTIVITY INDEX BY ECONOMY



According to the results of a monthly survey of 459 enterprises in the real sector, in March 2021 the business activity index exceeded 50 for the first time since the beginning of 2020, reaching **50.6** (in February – 49,0).

In the service sector the index formed at **51,2**, in manufacture – **50,2**, in construction – **46,5** (in February – 49,2, 49,0, 47,4, respectively).





#### **BUSINESS ACTIVITY INDEX BY SECTOR**



\*\* A value of the indicator above the 50 level means a positive change, below the 50 level - a negative one. The further (higher or lower) the value of the index from the level 50, the higher the rate of change (increase or decrease) of the indicator.


Business activity index for the **services** and **industrial sectors** moved into the growth area, amounting to **51.2** and **50.2**, respectively. The indicator in the industry turned out to be in the positive area due to the increase in the volume of inventories, shorter delivery times and an increase in new orders. In the service sector, improvement was noted in all components of the index.

The downward trend in business activity continued in **construction**, the indicator amounted to **46.5**, having decreased by 0.9 points due to the deterioration of all components of the index.



#### **BAI dynamics for February - March 2021**



In the context of the regions, an improvement in the business activity was observed in 10 regions of Kazakhstan: North Kazakhstan region (60.9), Kostanay region (56.9), Shymkent city (54.2), Karaganda region (53.5), Pavlodar region (53.3), Akmola region (52.1), Nur-Sultan city (51.1), Kyzylorda region (50.2), Zhambyl region (50.0) and Aktobe region (50.0).

The deterioration of the business activity was observed in 7 regions of Kazakhstan: in Turkestan (42.3), Almaty (46.2), Mangistau (46.3), East Kazakhstan (46.5), Atyrau (46.8), West Kazakhstan (47.5) regions and Almaty city (47.6).




#### **BUSINESS CLIMATE INDEX (BCI)**

#### **Current situation assessment**



\*Balance of answers (BA) is difference between positive and negative answers. Enterprises asked to assess the current business situation choosing one of the given answers «favorable», «unfavorable» and «neutral». Answers are weighted by respondents' size.

If index is above 0 improvement, if below 0 – worsening.




In March 2021 respondents estimated that the current business environment improved.

The indicator increased from **0.4** to **1.5**. An improvement in business conditions was noted in the service sector, a deterioration in construction and industry.

In March enterprises noted an increase in demand. The balance of answers\* for the economy was **3.4** (in February (-)5.3). The indicator in the industry was **6.4**, in the service sector - **2.3**. In construction was a slight decrease in demand ((-) **1.2**).

Enterprises in all sectors gave a negative assessment of the tax burden (-3.1) and business protection issues (-1.2). The respondents assessed the demand positively (3.4), as well as access to finance/loans and communications, (0.7 and 0.3, respectively).

## **BUSINESS CLIMATE INDEX (BCI)**Business cycle clock





In March 2021, according to the respondents the balance of answers on assessing the current business conditions was **1.5**. The balance of answers on expectations for the next **6 months** was **(18.6)**. Optimistic expectations and positive assessment of the current situation correspond to the area of **boom** in the business cycle clock. Thus, it can be concluded that the economy of Kazakhstan continues the recovery process in March 2021, after the recession associated with the coronavirus, and there is a transition to the growth area.

The business climate index, which is an average assessment of current and future business conditions, deteriorated slightly in the economy as a whole, amounting to 9.9 (in February - 11.9). The decrease in the BCI is associated with a decrease in optimism in assessing the future business conditions (from 24.0 to 18.6). In construction the indicator is significantly higher (13.3), while in industry the indicator turned out to be lower than the in the economy (6.8). The BCI in the service sector is 11.0.



#### METHODOLOGICAL COMMENT

- ✓ The information was prepared based on the results of monthly surveys of enterprises participating in the monitoring of the real sector.
- ✓ To calculate the Business Activity Index, the diffusion index (DI) is used, which is calculated as the sum of positive responses and half of the responses unchanged. This index is a generalized indicator characterizing the dynamics of changes in the indicator.
- ✓ The data on the diagram are presented with the elimination of the seasonality factor.
- ✓ Changes are possible in the previous months dynamics due to seasonal clearing and GDP adjustment.
- ✓ The Business Climate Index and Business Cycle Clock are constructed using the methodology of Ifo institute, Germany.
