

Inflation trends in the regions

March 2022

Annual inflation in March 2022 amounted to 12.0% (in February - 8.7%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 15.4% (in February - 10.0%), for non-food products - by 10.9% (in February - 8.6%), for paid services - by 8.3% (in February - 7.1%).

By regions annual inflation accelerated in all 17 regions. The greatest acceleration was recorded in Aktobe region (from 9.0% in February to 12.9% in March) and Shymkent city (from 8.5% to 12.4%). Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 5 regions, among which the highest value was recorded in Aktobe and Turkistan regions (12.9% for each).

Food products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (15.4%) in Aktobe (18.5%), Turkistan (17.2%) regions, Shymkent city (17.2%), Zhambyl (16.7%), North Kazakhstan (16.4%), Akmola (16.2%), Mangystau (16.0%) regions, Almaty city (15.8%) and Kostanay region (15.5%).

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (10.9%) increased in Akmola (12.4%), Aktobe (12.3%), Karaganda (11.5%), East Kazakhstan (11.5%), Kyzylorda (11.4%), Atyrau (11.2%) and Turkistan (11.0%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country increased by 8.3%, while the growth was higher than the national level in Almaty (9.4%), West Kazakhstan (9.4%), East Kazakhstan (9.1%) regions, NurSultan (9.0%) and Almaty (8.8%) cities, as well as Turkistan (8.7%), Karaganda (8.5%) and Mangystau (8.5%) regions.

In March 2022 **monthly** inflation in the country amounted to **3.7%**, which is higher than the average March inflation over the past 5 years (for 2017-2021). Prices rose above their historical average in March 2022 in all **17** regions. The greatest acceleration of monthly inflation growth rates was noted in Shymkent city (4.3%).
