

## Inflation trends in the regions

## April 2022

Annual inflation in April 2022 amounted to 13.2% (in March - 12.0%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 17.9% (in March - 15.4%), for non-food products - by 11.1% (in March - 10.9%), for paid services - by 8.9% (in March - 8.3%).

By regions annual inflation accelerated in all 17 regions. The greatest acceleration was recorded in Turkistan region (from 12.9% in March to 15.5% in April). As a result, annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 7 regions, among which the highest value was recorded in Turkistan region.

**Food** products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (17.9%, YoY) in Turkistan (21.3%), Aktobe (19.8%), Mangystau (19.6%), Akmola and Zhambyl regions (18.9% each), as well as Almaty city (18.4%) and North-Kazakhstan region (18.2%).

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (11.1%, YoY) increased in Turkistan, East Kazakhstan regions and Nur-Sultan city (12.4% each), as well as Akmola (12.3%), Atyrau (12.0%), Aktobe and Karaganda (11.5% each) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country increased by 8.9%, YoY, while the growth was higher than the national level in East Kazakhstan (10.8%), Turkistan (10.3%), Karaganda (9.9%) regions, as well as West Kazakhstan region and Nur-Sultan city (9.8%), Almaty and Mangystau regions (9.1% each).

In April 2022 **monthly** inflation in the country amounted to **2.0%**, which is higher than the average April inflation over the past 5 years (for 2017-2021). Prices rose above their historical average in April 2022 in all **17** regions. The greatest acceleration of monthly inflation growth rates was noted in Turkistan region (3.0%).
