## Inflation trends in the regions

## May 2022

Annual inflation in May 2022 amounted to 14.0% (in April - 13.2%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 19.0% (in April - 17.9%), for non-food products - by 11.9% (in April - 11.1%), for paid services - by 9.1% (in April - 8.9%).

By regions annual inflation accelerated in 15 regions and slowed down in 2 regions. The largest accelerations were recorded in Mangystau (from 13.9% in April to 15.2% in May), Karaganda (from 13.5% to 14.8%) and West Kazakhstan (from 12.2% to 13.5%) regions. Slowdowns in annual inflation were noted in Turkistan (from 15.5% to 15.4%) and Zhambyl (from 13.2% to 13.1%) regions. Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 5 regions, among which the highest value was recorded in the Turkistan region (15.4%).

**Food** products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (19.0% YoY) in Mangystau (21.0%), Aktobe and Turkistan (20.7% each), Zhambyl (19.9%) regions, Shymkent (19.8%) and Almaty (19.6%) cities, as well as Akmola region (19.1%).

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (11.9% YoY) increased in Nur-Sultan city (14.3%), East Kazakhstan (13.5%), Karaganda (13.3%), Mangystau (13.1%), Atyrau (12.6%), Akmola (12.5%) and Turkistan (12.1%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country increased by 9.1% YoY, while the growth was higher than the national level in East Kazakhstan (11.4%), Turkistan (11.1%), Karaganda (10.5%), West Kazakhstan (9.5%) and Mangystau (9.3%) regions.

In May 2022 **monthly** inflation in the country amounted to **1.4%**, which is significantly higher than the average May inflation over the past 5 years (for 2017-2021). In all **17** regions, prices rose above their historical average in May 2022. The greatest acceleration of monthly inflation was noted in the Mangystau region (2.2%).
