




## Inflation trends in the regions

### June 2022

Annual inflation in June 2022 amounted to 14.5% (in May - 14.0%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 19.2% (in May - 19.0%), for non-food products - by 13.2% (in May - 11.9%), for paid services - by 9.2% (in May - 9.1%).

By regions annual inflation accelerated in 16 regions, slowed down in 1 region. The greatest acceleration was recorded in Mangystau (from 15.2% in May to 17.0% in June) and Akmola (from 13.9% to 15.3%) regions. A slowdown in annual inflation was noted in East Kazakhstan region (from 14.5% to 14.3%). Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 7 regions, among which the highest value was recorded in Mangystau region (17.0%).

**Food** products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (19.2% YoY) in Mangystau (23.6%), Aktobe (21.1%), Turkistan (21.0%), Atyrau and Zhetysu (20.1% each), Akmola (20.0%), Zhambyl (19.6%) regions, Almaty and Shymkent cities (19.5% each), as well as North Kazakhstan region (19.3%).

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (13.2% YoY) increased in Nur-Sultan city (16.4%), Karaganda (15.3%), Mangystau (15.1%), Ulytau (14.8%), Akmola (14.6%), Abai (14.3%), Atyrau and East Kazakhstan (13.9% each), North Kazakhstan and Zhetysu (13.8% each), as well as Kyzylorda (13.4%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country increased by 9.2% YoY, while the growth was higher than the national level in Turkistan (11.4%), Karaganda and East Kazakhstan (11.3% each), Ulytau (10.8 %), Abai (10.7%), West Kazakhstan (9.7%), Mangystau (9.6%) regions.

In June 2022 monthly inflation in the country amounted to **1.6%**, which is significantly higher than the average June inflation over the past 5 years (for 2017-2021). In all regions, prices rose above the historical average in June 2022. The greatest acceleration of monthly inflation was noted in the Mangystau region (2.6%).
