




# Inflation trends in the regions

December 2022

Annual inflation in December 2022 amounted to 20.3% (in November - 19.6%). Prices for food products over the year increased by 25.3% (in November - 24.1%), for non-food products - by 19.4% (in November - 18.6%), for paid services - retained their previous value at the level of 14.1%.

By regions annual inflation accelerated in 19 regions, and in 1 region (Almaty region) it slowed down. Annual inflation turned out to be higher than the national level in 7 regions. The highest values of annual inflation were recorded in Mangystau region (24.0%), Astana city (23.0%) and Akmola region (21.1%).

**Food** products in Kazakhstan rose in price above the national level (25.3% YoY) in Mangystau (31.6%), Turkistan (27.5%), Aktobe and Zhambyl regions (by 26.0%), Shymkent city (25.9%), Akmola and North Kazakhstan (25.7% each), Pavlodar (25.6%), Karaganda and Kostanay (25.4% each) regions.

Prices for **non-food** products are higher than in the country (19.4% YoY) increased in Astana city (30.5%), East Kazakhstan (20.5%), Turkistan (19.8%) and North Kazakhstan (19.6%) regions.

Prices for **paid services** in the country remained unchanged at the level of 14.1% YoY, while the growth was higher than the national level in Mangystau (17.8%), Ulytau (17.3%), Karagandy (16.4%), Almaty city (16.2%), Akmola (16.1%), West Kazakhstan (15.1%), Abai (14.4%), as well as North Kazakhstan and Zhetysu (14.2% each) areas.

In December 2022 monthly inflation in the country amounted to **1.2%**, which is significantly higher than the average December inflation over the past 5 years (0.7% for 2017-2021). In all regions, with the exception of the Almaty region, prices in December 2022 rose above the historical average. The highest values of monthly inflation were noted in Zhambyl and Kostanay regions (1.9% each).
