In May 2023 the volume of remittances transferred via international money transfer systems (hereinafter - IMTS) was 260.1 thousand transactions in the amount of 94.8 billion tenge. Compared to April 2023, there is an increase in the number of transfers by 5.4% and the volume of transactions by 10.6%.

Kazakhstan's commercial banks and JSC «Kazpost» provide to the customer's remittances services through IMTS such as the Golden Crown, Western Union, Unistream, Contact, Faster, MoneyGram and others IMTS.

IMTS are used by the Kazakhstan's population as for transfers within the country and for sending /receiving money transfers abroad / from abroad.

The share of remittances carried out through IMTS on the territory of Kazakhstan in May 2023 is 6.2% of the total number of transfers and 5.2% of the total volume of remittances. The share of remittances sent abroad is 93.8% and 94.9%, respectively.

#### **CROSS-BORDER REMITTANCES**

#### REMMITANCES SENT ABROAD

In May 2023 abroad were transferred via IMTS 243.9 thousands transactions in the amount of 90.0 billion tenge. Compared to April 2023, the number of money transfers sent increased by 11.4%, the volume increased by 17.7%.

In terms of the volume of money sent from Kazakhstan abroad, the leaders are: Uzbekistan -29.9 billion tenge (share -33.2%), Russia -19.8 billion tenge (share of the total amount of 22.0%), Turkey -18.9 billion tenge (share -21.0%), Georgia -9.1 billion tenge (share -10.2%), and China -2.9 billion tenge (share -3.2%).





#### **RECEIVED REMITTANCES (FROM ABROAD)**

In May 2023 from abroad to Kazakhstan were transferred via IMTS 101.9 thousands transaction in the amount of 28.0 billion tenge. Compared to April 2023, the number and volume of money transfers received increased by 2.1% and 6.5%, respectively.

In terms of the amount of money received from abroad, the leaders are: Russia - 10.6 billion tenge (share of the total amount - 37.8%), the United States of America - 3.1 billion tenge (share - 11.1%), the Republic of Korea - 3.0 billion tenge (share - 10.7%), Uzbekistan - 2.8 billion tenge (share - 10.1%), as well as Turkey 1.7 billion tenge (share - 6.2%).







#### **REMITTANCES WITHIN KAZAKHSTAN**


