



Inflation trends in the regions

January 2024

Annual inflation in January 2024 amounted to 9.5% (in December 2023 – 9.8%). The prices for food and non-food products, as well as services slowed down in annual terms to 8.2% (in December 2023 - 8.5%), to 8.6% (in December 2023 - 9.1%) and to 12.3% (in December 2023 – 12.4%), respectively.

By regions annual inflation slowed down in 15 regions, accelerated in 3 regions and remained unchanged in 2 regions. Annual inflation was higher than the national level in 10 regions. The highest annual inflation rates were recorded in Karaganda (11.3%), Mangystau (10.6%), Atyrau and East Kazakhstan (10.1%) regions.

Food prices rose in Kazakhstan higher than the national level (8.2% YoY) in Ulytau (11.3%), Akmola (9.5%) regions, Almaty city (9.3%), East Kazakhstan (9.2%), Abai (9.1%), Zhetysu (8.9%), North Kazakhstan (8.8%), Atyrau and Mangystau (8.7 each), as well as in Karaganda (8.6%) regions.

The increase in prices for **non-food** products is higher than in the country (8.6% YoY) was noted in Mangystau (12.9%), Karaganda (10.4%), West Kazakhstan (9.2%) regions, Shymkent city and Akmola region (9.1% each), Zhambyl (9.0%), Turkistan and East Kazakhstan (8.8% each) regions.

Above the national level (12.3% YoY) prices for **paid services** rose in the following regions: Turkistan (17.3%), Karaganda (15.7%), Atyrau (15.3%), Zhetysu (14.3 %), Pavlodar (14.2%), Aktobe (13.7%), Shymkent city (13.4%), East Kazakhstan (13.0%), North Kazakhstan (12.7%) and Abai (12.4%) regions.

In January 2024 monthly inflation in the country was 0.8%, which is higher than the historical averageⁱ (0.6% in January 2017-2021). The highest monthly inflation was noted in Atyrau region (1.2%).
